I understand that you are interested in Elliotts. I would like to tell you about the Elliott Family Quarterly.

This is our second year, and this is what we offer.

The first three issues of every year will have sections on census extractions, land records, probate records, vitals, court records, book extractions, misc. (military records, emmigration, etc.), reader lineages, "very interesting", and queries. I try to have data from at least seven different states in each issue. The fourth issue will have vitals from varying sources (newspapers, cemeteries, state, county and city, etc.) from at least seven different states. It will also contain queries and the index for the entire year. Last years issues contained 127 pages.

This March will see a start of a new section on Elliotts (all spellings as always) of Ireland, Scotland and England. The subscription for 1986 will be \$14.00 for the year. I hope to keep it at that level for a few years. All issues are sent first class mail.

I also have a microfilm "sponser" program. My mother (Ilah [Spencer] Elliott) and her sister (Mrs. Lloyd [Lola Spencer] Stephens), and my son (Mark) contributed much material I have on this family and associated *FRANKLIN and LONG families*. I also have been assisted by members of the Ringgold County Genealogical Society.

I would much appreciate additional contributions to history and additional data on descendants, letters, and pictures. I have started compiling a group of letters written by members of this family and plan on these to be included in an appendix of a history of the Spencer Family. I would appreciate additional contributions to these along with other history data, including military records, etc. Remember that we descended from common people and common people deserve to be remembered! Any material provided will be valued.

I also would welcome some co-authors on preparing the Spencer Family History.

For those interested in technical matters, this material was compiled by use of software purchased from and published by the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints of Salt Lake City, Utah, for the bargain price of \$35 delivered. (For the record, writer is member of the United Methodist Church but an admirer of their work in genealogy.) This PERSONAL ANCESTRAL FILE software was written for the "PC" but undoubtedly be written for other systems soon. My computer is a Columbia, an IBM clone, and printer is an Epson 100. In order to handle the more than 700 names on this disk, I found I had to double the capacity the capacity from 128K to 256K (the original IBM-PC had 64K). It has the capability of printing any family sheet or pedigree sheet compressed on 8 1/2 by 11 or uncompressed on 11 by 14 1/2. The program assigns the individual (RIN) numbers and the family (MRIN) numbers. It will print out four generation pedigree charts by giving the machine the RIN number. Some families in this file are not Rush descendants but parents and grandparents SPENCER

of individuals that married into the Spencer family. They have been added to the disk for the purpose of making the pedigree charts more complete when printed. These family sheets are not complete in the file and it wasn't intended to print them as part as this collection of families.

I admire the work of the members of the Ringgold Society and appreciate the help they have already given me.
