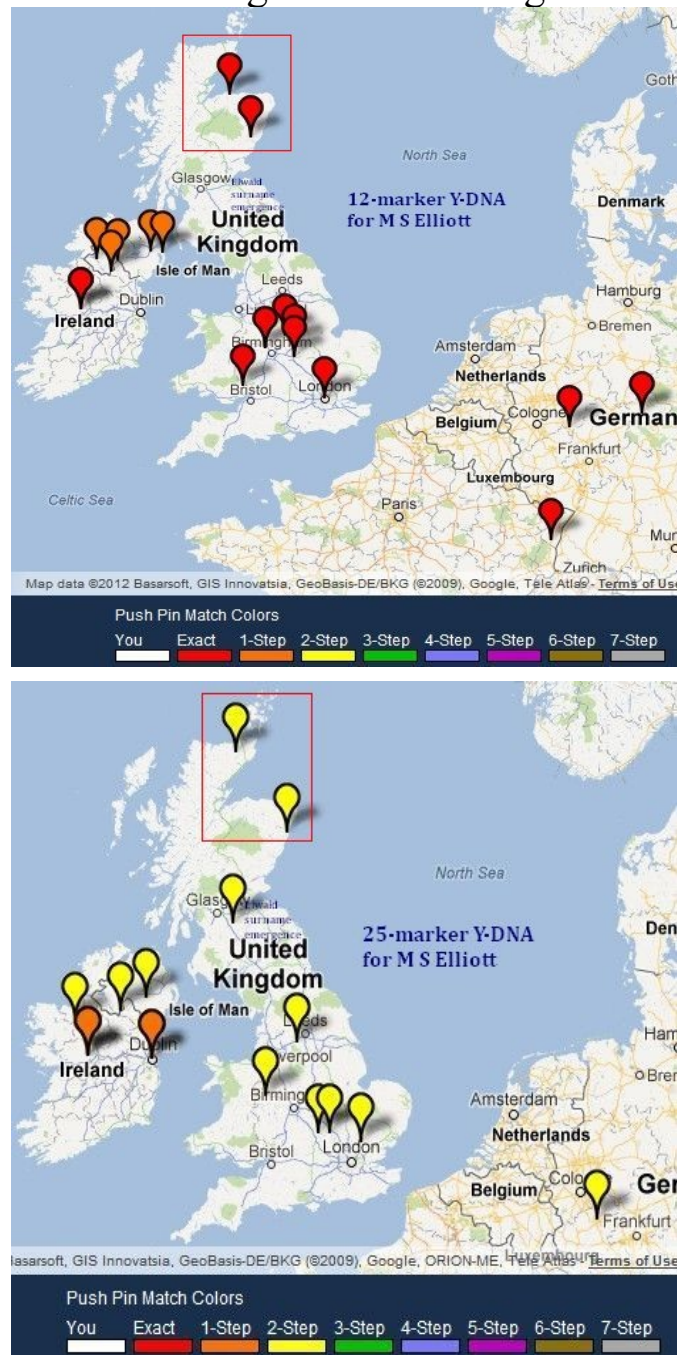


Chasing my Y-DNA part 13

ELLIOT

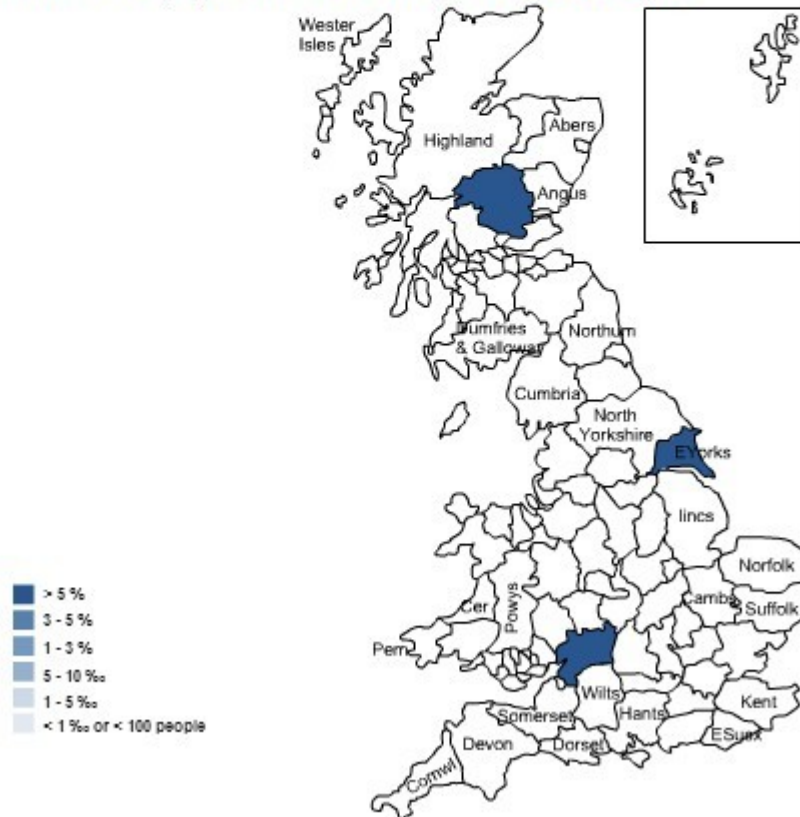
In Great Britain : **6 448** people share the surname Elliot according to our estimation
The surname Elliot is the **1 585th** most common name in Great Britain.

GEOGRAPHICAL SPREAD

This map shows the geographical spread by county of surname Elliot in Great Britain. For example below that over 5 % people whose name is Elliot live in **Perth and Kinross**.



Elwald in Redheugh evolve into the Scottish surname Elliot then became an English surname Elliot. The Gloucestershire, England region which is blue is felt not a region in which Elliot was derived originally from Elwald.

The Perthshire, Scotland is felt to been settled by the cleansing of the Border region just north of Northumbria. The Elliot of East Riding York most are felt to be derived from Elwald.

ELLWOOD

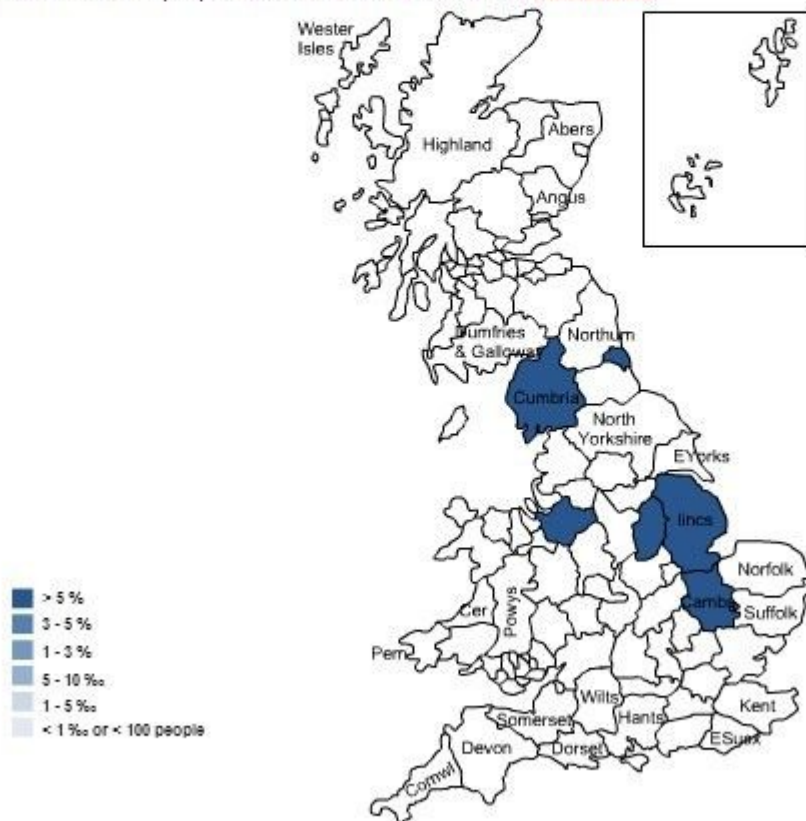
In Great Britain : **10 766** people share the surname Ellwood according to our estimation
The surname Ellwood is the **940th** most common name in Great Britain.

This map shows the geographical spread by county of surname Ellwood in Great Britain. For example you can see below that over 5 % people whose name is Ellwood live in **Lincolnshire**.

It is felt that the Ellwood name is derived from Elwald which becomes Elwold or starts as Elwold then become Elwould or similar then evolves into Ellwood. It should be noted that Ellwood is an English (Elwood is English or Scottish) name but migrated an Anglo-Saxon name likely from south of East Riding Yorkshire. Norfolk is known to have a Church of St Elwold. Yorkshire has area referred to as Wolds.

The Liddell is where the Elwald of Liddesdale were from.

Given that Liddell is a surname along with a geographic name we find Liddell;

LIDDELL

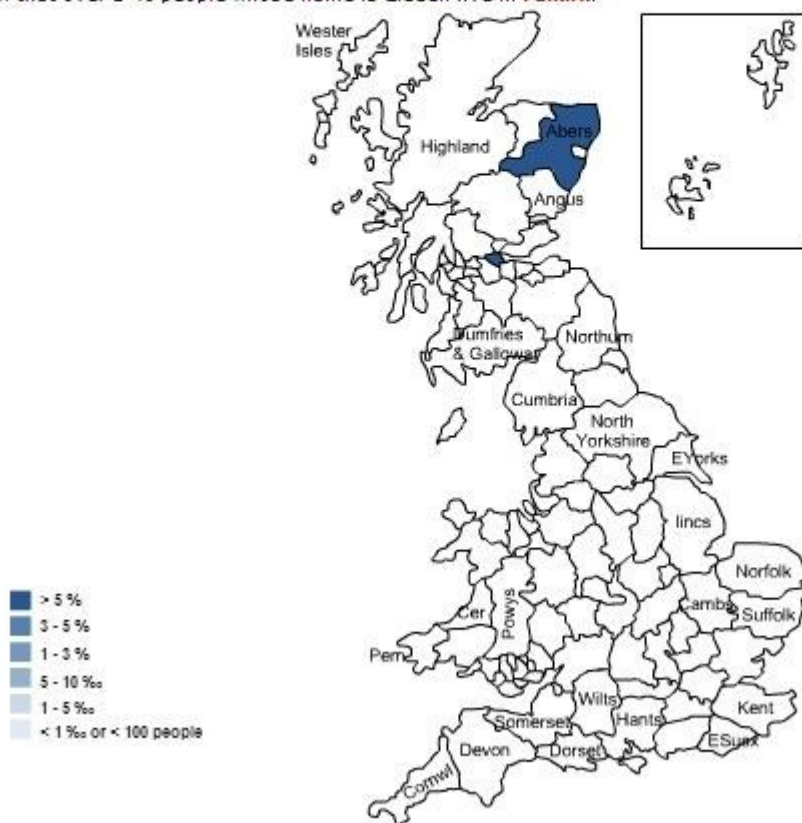
In Great Britain : **3 189** people share the surname Liddell according to our estimation
The surname Liddell is the **3 308th** most common name in Great Britain.

This map shows the geographical spread by county of surname Liddell in Great Britain. For example you can see below that over 5 % people whose name is Liddell live in **Falkirk**.



Which strongly indicates people with my Y-DNA resettled from the region of the Liddell to northeast Scotland.

It is felt that the region of northeast Scotland may have been available for resettlement, because it was an area others would prefer not to resettle in.
