DEATH OF MRS. BENJAMIN RUSH

Nancy Arminta Chapman was born March 30, 1837, in Monroe Co., Kentucky, and died Saturday, September 10, 1898, at the home of her daughter, Mrs. C. E. Tedrow of Poe Township, aged 60 years, six months, and 20 days. She was married in 1859 to Benjamin Rush to whom were born ten children, eight of whom survive, as follows: James J. of Guthrie, Okla., Andrew J. of Blackburn, Okla., Dennis B., Robert L., Aaron, Mrs. J. H. Schulze, Mrs. C. E. Tedrow, and Mrs. A. R. Stark. In 1875 she moved with her family to Ringgold County, where she has since resided most of the time in Middle Fork Township. Her fatal illness, ulceration of the stomach, was of two months duration.

The funeral was conducted at 11 o'clock Sunday from the Middle Fork Chapel, by Rev. C. E. Wells. Internment was made in the adjoining cemetery, where lies the remains of Mrs. Rush's two children who have preceded her across the river. Of her living children all but Andrew were present at the funeral.

Mrs. Rush united with the Baptist Church at 16 years of age, and remained a faithful member until death. During her last illness, she bore extreme suffering with never-failing patience. She expressed herself as not only willing but anxious to be at rest with her Maker.

added to his and now owns $3\frac{1}{2}$ acres, altogether, in Sec. 16. There were about 8 acres broken, and a log cabin built on the Rankins tract. Mr. Rush built a frame house, measuring 14 x 22 feet, in which he lived until his present stone house of one story and with 18 inch walls, was completed in 1892. He cultivates about half of the farm, and raises stock, preferring shorthorn cattle and Berkshire hogs. He also feeds largely for others. There is an excellent water supply on the farm, furnished by the south fork of Rock Creek, or Wild Cat Branch, which has its source in the flint hills. He also has a good well, 15 feet deep.

Mr. Rush was united in marriage with Sarah Elizabeth Cable, who was born June 19, 1853, and is of Dutch-Irish descent. She is a daughter of Stephen and Rachel (Speer) Cable. Her mother died in 1861, and her father is living at Hewins, Kansas, and was 78 years old on April 2, 1901. They were the parents of four children: Sarah Elizabeth; Bennett, of Chautauqua County, Kansas; Nancy (Bennett), of Galesburg, Illinois; and Payton P. of the same place. She died in Chautauqua County in June 1892, leaving three children: Mary (Moore) who lives on her father's farm; Willis, a resident of Chautauqua County; and Sherman, of Golden, Missouri. Mr. and Mrs. Rush became the parents of eleven children, two of whom died in infancy. The following nine survive: Isaac S. who married Ora Higgins, and is a farmer of Cowley County; William Jefferson, who was born in 1873, and married Mary E. Gregory; Mary E. McBride, who is a teacher in Creek County; as is her husband; Nancy Ellen (Meade) of Cowley County; Daniel H., Jr., of Chautauqua County; Celestia Rachael (Beucy), of Chautauqua County; Rebecca; Charles H.; and Joshua Homer, who attends school. Politically, Mr. Rush and his family are Republicans. He has served on the township board, and has been township treasurer and road overseer. He assisted in the organization of school district No. 142, in 1885, and is a member of its board at the present time. Religiously, he is a Baptist, and attends Lookout Valley Church.

AARON RUSH, farmer, section 3, Middle Fork Township, was born in Monroe County, Kentucky, Dec. 8, 1826. His parents were Benjamin and Rachel (Springer) Rush, the former a native of Virginia, and the latter of South Carolina. They were married in Kentucky and reared a family of thirteen children; James, Ezekiel, Martha, William, Dennis, Desire, Hiram, Joshua, Benjamin, John, Aaron, Rachel, and Isaac. Aaron was reared on a farm, and obtained his education in the common schools. He was married in Sept., 1847, to Miss Hammer, born in Monroe County, New York, daughter of John and Sarah (Miller) Hammer. In 1849 he removed to Fayette County, Illinois, where he lived for four years, thence to McDonough County, where he resided until the fall of 1865; then came to Ringgold County, locating in Rice Township, where he improved 160 acres of wild land. In 1869 he sold out and purchased his present farm, which has been partially improved. He has 120 acres, consisting largely of bottom lands on the west fork of Grand River, and it is one of the best stock farms in the vicinity, out buildings for stock, a good bearing orchard and small fruits. Mr. and Mrs. Rush are the parents of twelve children; James, John, Martha, Siratus M., Rosetta, Loretta, Josiah Grant, Ella M., Emma O., Peter, Isaac, and Narcissa. The deceased are Sarah, Elizabeth, and Thomas Jefferson. Mr. Rush has been a worthy member of the Methodist Episcopal Church for forty years. Politically he is a Republican and strong Prohibitionist. P.O. Delphos.

I was real young when she would talk about the Old William and the old James. I always heard that my father James Thomas Rush was named for this Old James. There is a mix-up along the line some place.)

William Rush is the oldest Rush I can find any record of. There aren't any dates to show when he came to Kentucky. There aren't any dates of his birth or death. Can't say how old he was at the time of his settling in Kentucky. There isn't any record of who he married, and if he had any other children but Benjamin and Joshua Rush. The records have long been destroyed. A number of older people have told me there used to be a family record of old William Rush and his immediate family. The strongest evidence pointing to the relationship to our side of the house is the Rush names handed down through each generation--down to my father James Thomas Rush. What information I gathered on William claims he was in Kentucky sometime in the 17th century. I don't know when he died or where he was buried. I don't know who he married. The above I picked up years ago from hearing the older ones talk.

Their son Ezekiel was named after his grandfather, Ezekiel Springer, so Winston Bailey told me many years ago. He said that Ezekiel Rush told him.
